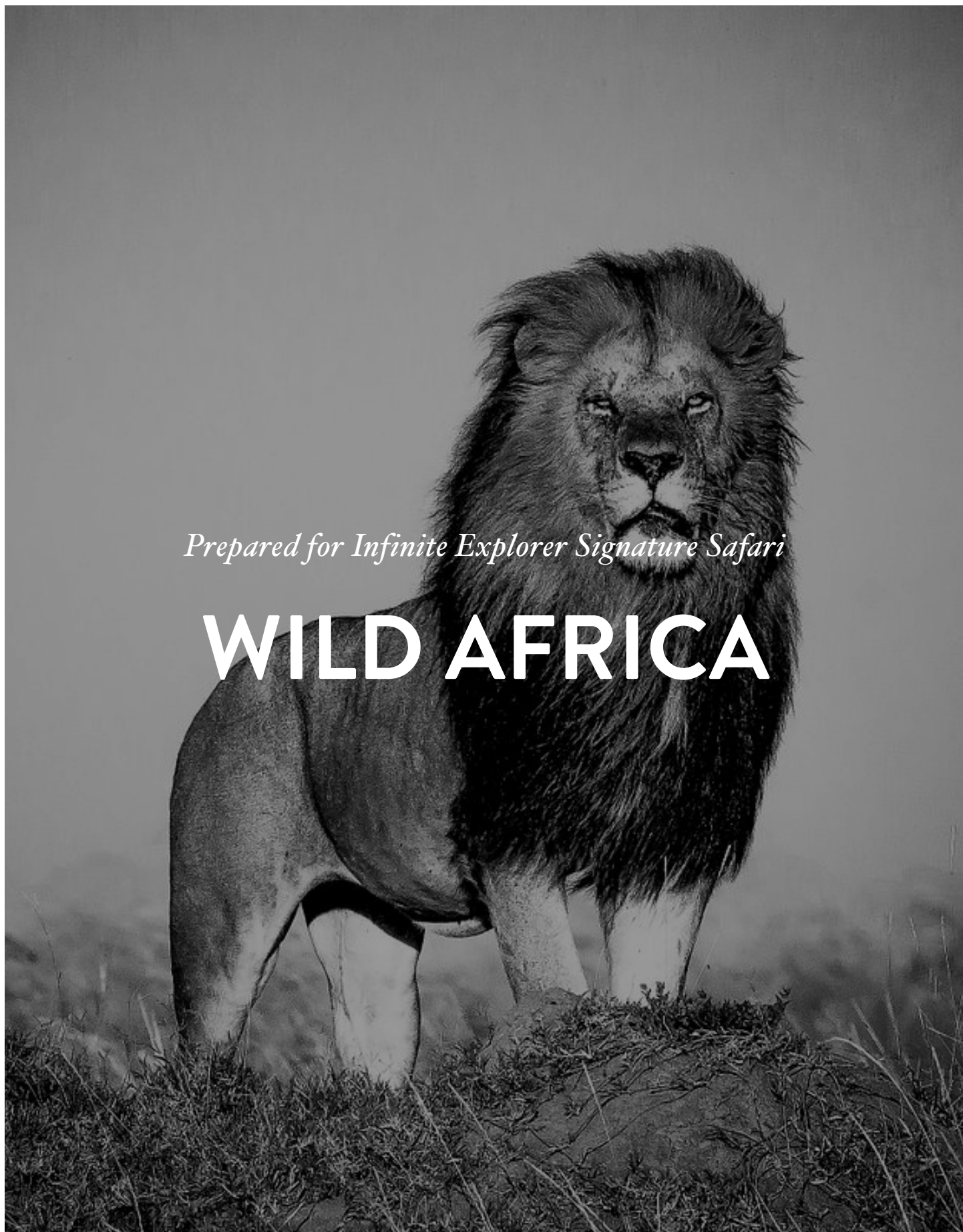

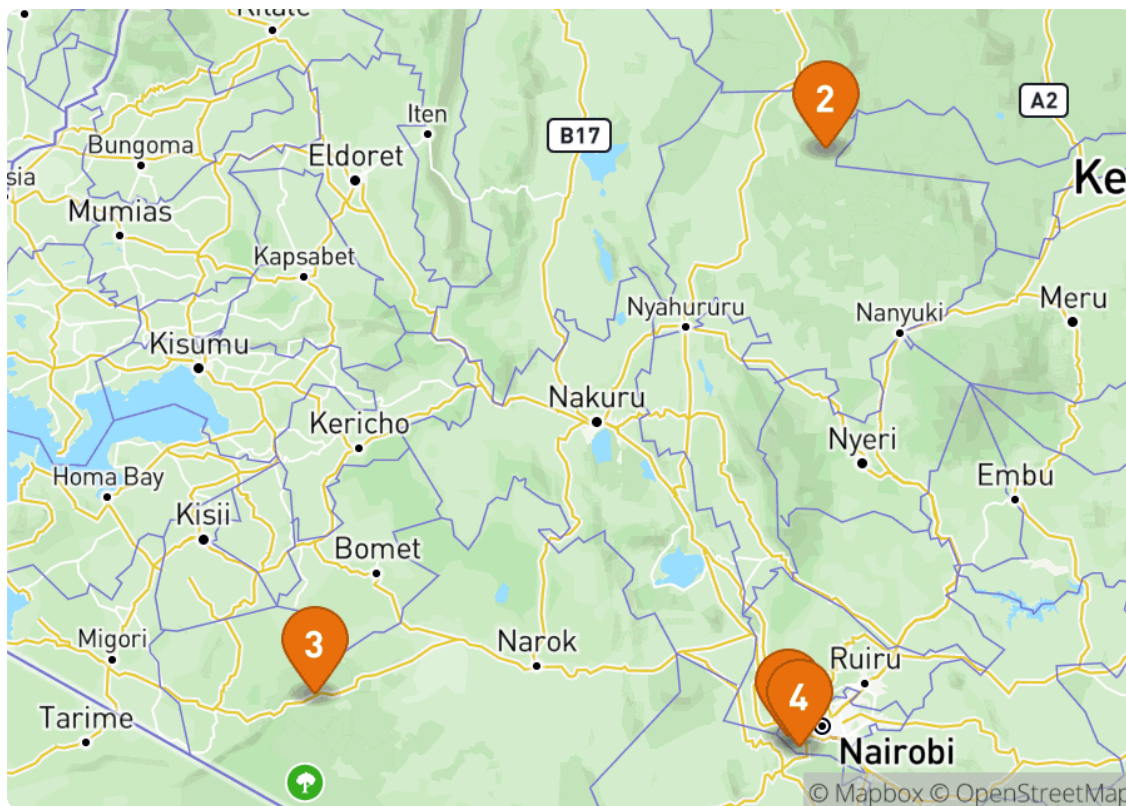

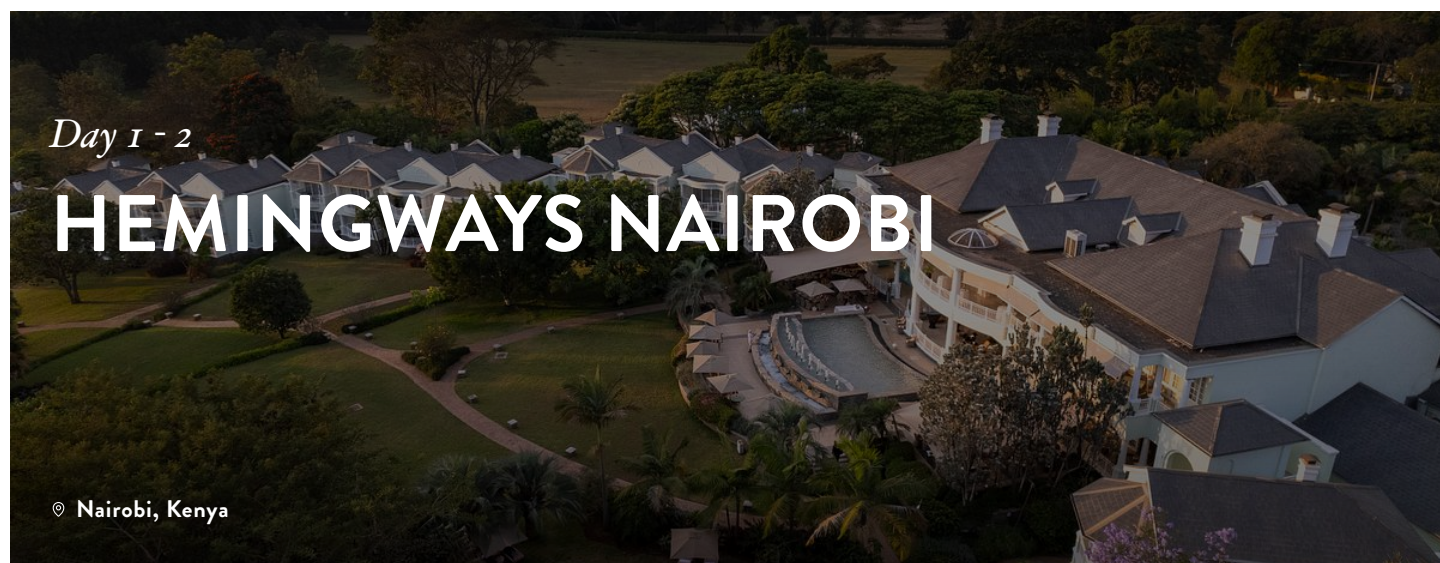


Nairobi

Area Overview

Nairobi is the capital of Kenya and East Africa's most cosmopolitan city, with a vibrant population of 4.5 million. Unique to the city is the proximity of Nairobi National Park, a true wilderness area juxtaposed against the larger urban metropolis. It is the only national park like it in the world and a real embodiment of the human-wildlife conflicts that challenge many African communities who must learn to cohabitate with wildlife on their doorstep.

Nairobi National Park is one of the best places in Africa to see rhino and also has a healthy population of lion, leopard, cheetah, and plains game like giraffe and antelope. Other attractions include the Karen Blixen Museum, the Giraffe Center, Daphne Sheldrick's Elephant Orphanage, a visit to a tea farm, and shopping for local crafts and trinkets. There are some great local and cross-cultural restaurants to explore, from roadside food stalls to local *nyama choma* (barbecue joints) to five-star dining establishments.

LOISABA CONSERVANCY

📍 Loisaba Conservancy, Kenya

Loisaba Conservancy

Area Overview

On the threshold of Kenya's beautiful northern rangelands, Laikipia covers 9,500km² north of the Aberdares Mountain Range on a wide plateau stretching from the slopes of Mt Kenya in the south east to the edge of the Great Rift Valley in the west. The striking escarpments descend into the surrounding arid land with tributaries of the Ewaso Nyiro River cutting across the vast open plains. The habitats range from dry savannah and open woodland to spectacular canyons and low forested valleys.

Made up of vast community-owned ranches, private farms and wildlife conservancies, Laikipia supports the second highest density of wildlife in Kenya and is one of only few places in Africa where wildlife numbers are on the increase. It is one of Kenya's most exciting wilderness areas with spectacular scenery and an abundance of wildlife, including many endangered species such as Grevy's zebra, reticulated giraffe, Lelwel's hartebeest and the patas monkey. Laikipia is also one of the best places to see wild dog.

Loisaba Conservancy lies on the edge of a sheer escarpment with views out over the Laikipia plateau. This thriving 230 km² conservancy boasts rivers, forests, springs, valleys and open plains. Recently purchased by the Loisaba Community Trust, with the assistance of The Nature Conservancy, and partnered with the Space For Giants elephant foundation, Loisaba is becoming a hub for cutting-edge conservation efforts throughout Laikipia and Kenya.



Three accommodations are available on Loisaba - the sophisticated Loisaba Tented Camp, the unique Loisaba Star Beds, and and the ultra-private Loisaba Lodo Springs.

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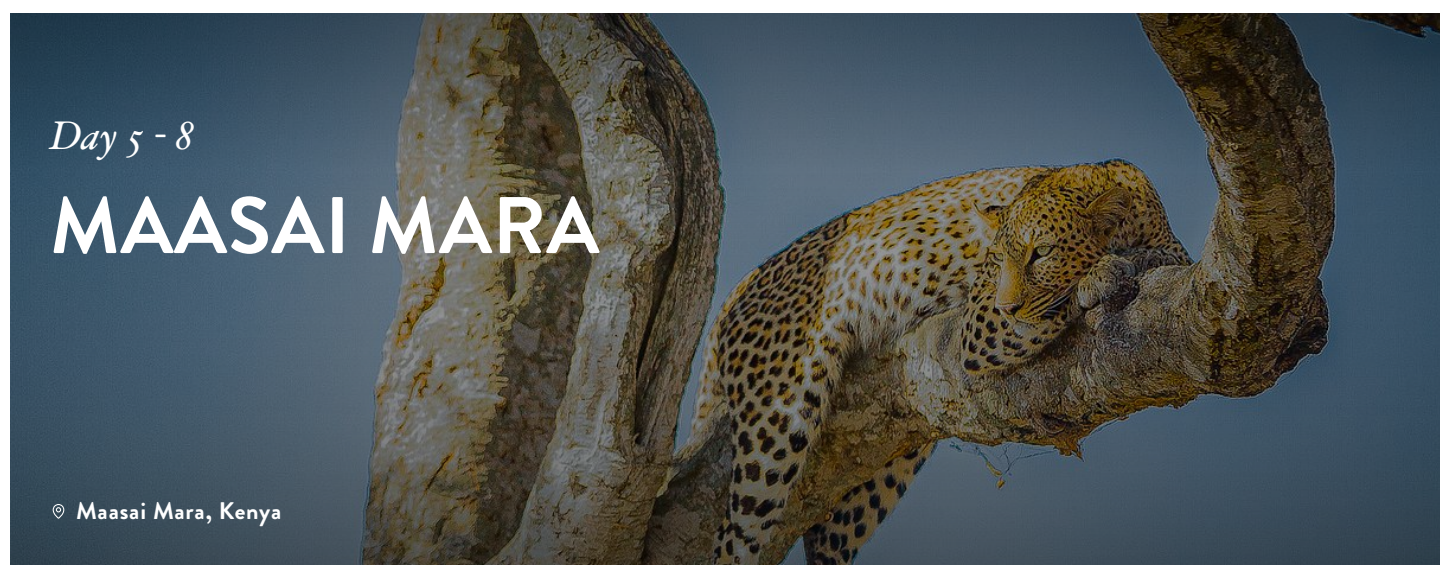

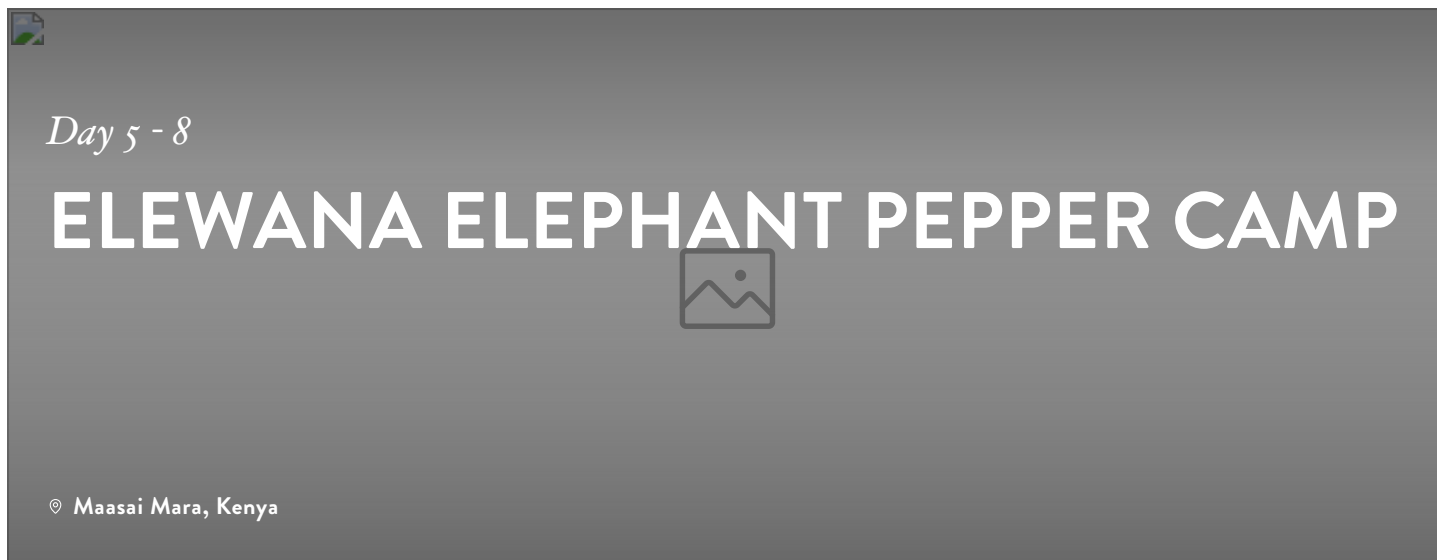
Maasai Mara

Area Overview

The Mara conservancies are Maasai owned group ranches that have combined to conserve a total area nearly the size of the Maasai Mara National Reserve itself, covering 1450 km² (560 mi²) across fifteen conservancies. The wildlife in the conservancies can be comparable to the main Maasai Mara game reserve, and in fact some areas have higher densities of predators than in the central reserve. Because there are fewer camps, the conservancies can offer a more exclusive experience than in the central reserve, with generally fewer game viewing vehicles around sightings.

There are opportunities in some conservancies to do night drives, walking safaris, as well as visits to some of the villages of the local Maasai who own the land.

The conservancy approach is widely seen as the way forward for wildlife conservation and eco-tourism in Kenya, because it not only secures vital space for wildlife but includes the local population as custodians of their national heritage. This has been vital not only for conservation of the whole greater Mara but also wildlife corridors and the prosperity of many hundreds of Maasai families. Nearly forty tourist camps contribute to employment amongst the communities and provide a presence, alongside Maasai anti poaching units, for the protection of the wildlife.



Elewana Elephant Pepper Camp

Property Overview

Elephant Pepper Camp is an intimate tented safari camp set in the private Mara North Conservancy within Kenya's Masai Mara ecosystem. Surrounded by fig and elephant pepper trees, the camp offers a blend of rustic charm and comfort with eight spacious luxury Safari Tents and two larger Honeymoon/Family Suites, all designed for privacy and views over the savannah. Facilities include a central lounge and dining area, a campfire setting, and relaxed outdoor spaces, where guests can enjoy freshly prepared cuisine and unwind under the stars while immersed in the sounds of the African bush.

Experience & Activities

The camp offers exceptional wildlife experiences led by highly experienced, certified guides, with access to exclusive game viewing in the conservancy and the wider Masai Mara. Activities include day and night game drives in specially designed 4x4 vehicles, guided bush walks for a closer look at the ecosystem, and full-day excursions to witness the Great Migration and river crossings. Guests can also enjoy bush breakfasts and sundowners in scenic locations, as well as family-friendly activities such as nature walks for children.

The private conservancy setting ensures fewer vehicles, enhancing the sense of exclusivity and providing outstanding opportunities to observe abundant wildlife, including big cats and seasonal migrations.

Giraffe Manor offers full-board stays, gourmet dining, and access to The Retreat, a wellness center with a gym, a spa, and an infinity pool. The room features three single beds—two of which can be combined for couples—a fireplace, and south-facing views over the sanctuary forest. Its en-suite bathroom includes a bathtub, a shower, and twin sinks, highlighted by a striking stained-glass wall. Guests can feed giraffes through the window during their morning visits. Amenities include free wifi, a coffee machine, fans, mosquito nets, a hair dryer, a safe, handmade Kenyan toiletries, and complimentary laundry.

ELECTRONIC TRAVEL AUTHORISATION TO KENYA

All travellers of all ages (except citizens of Kenya and EAC partner countries) arriving in Kenya are required to apply for Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA) online prior to departure:

Online applications via www.etakenya.go.ke

ETA's are valid for a single entry to Kenya for a maximum stay duration of 3 months. Passports must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the travel date and must have one blank page.

ETA FEES

\$34.09 per person - Standard Processing

NB: The above-quoted fee is subject to change.

All previous visa entry requirements for Kenya are now replaced by the requirement for ETA's.

Travellers with existing issued visas will be granted access to Kenya within the validity period of 90 days, without the additional requirement for an ETA.

ETA's are valid for travel for 3 months from the date of application, regardless of the submitted arrival date in Kenya.

Transit passengers arriving and leaving by the same aircraft or transferred to another aircraft and who do not leave the airport terminal are exempt from the requirement of an ETA.

Travellers arriving in Kenya whose itineraries include a visit to any EAC country (Democratic Republic of



the Congo, Burundi, Rwanda, Somalia, South Sudan, Uganda or Tanzania) followed by a re-entry into Kenya will be able to use their original ETA for re-entry into Kenya.

Kenya ETA Application Guide

All travellers of all ages (except citizens of Kenya, EAC partner states and Ghana) arriving in Kenya are required to apply for Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA) online prior to departure via www.etaKenya.go.ke

To simplify the process, we have created the below step-by-step guide to completing the ETA application. Before you begin your application, please make sure that you have the following documents:

1. Passport style photo or functioning webcam to take a photograph during application - JPEG
1. Copy of the Bio-Data page of your passport - JPEG or PDF
2. Copy of your flight booking confirmation (including arrival and departure details and your full name) - JPEG or PDF
4. Copy of your safari itinerary from your tour operator - JPEG or PDF

NB: The passport style photo cannot be a photo of the photograph in your passport and must be clear, in colour, with no hats or hair covering the face and without glasses)

Passports must be valid for at least 6 months after the planned date of arrival in Kenya and have at least one blank page.

- applications for a family, couple or friends travelling together in group of up to 9 travellers

Medical Suggestions & Vaccination Requirements

HEPATITIS A - Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda & Rwanda

Recommended for unvaccinated travellers age one year and older.

HEPATITIS B - Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda & Rwanda

Recommended for unvaccinated travellers of all ages.

MALARIA - Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda & Rwanda

Malaria is a serious parasitic disease, which is common in Africa, Asia, and South America. It is spread by mosquito bites and may, after an incubation period of 1-3 weeks, rapidly lead to life-threatening complications, particularly in individuals with little or no immunity.

There is no 100% effective solution but there are a number of good prevention methods available. The recommendations given below have been gathered from documented figures and our wide experience throughout East Africa.

Avoiding mosquito bites is the cornerstone of protection. The malaria-carrying Anopheles mosquito usually feeds after dark, from about 21:00 until 06:00 hours. Avoid the mosquito by:

- Using a mosquito bed net when not in a tent;
- Wearing long clothing after dark
- Applying repellents/ spraying insecticides after dark

If you decide to take prophylaxis for malaria, the best drug is Malarone.

- Malarone should be taken a day before exposure, daily during exposure, and a week after return. The drug is available worldwide. The drug cannot be taken by pregnant or lactating women but is safe for



children above bodyweight of 11 kgs. Pediatric tablets are available.

- The alternative could be Doxycycline. Again the drug should be taken daily, a day before exposure, during and for 3 weeks after exposure, one tablet a day. The drug cannot be taken by pregnant or lactating women or children under the age of 12 years. Avoidance of exposure to the sun is recommended.
- Mefloquine (Lariam). Is not recommended due to severe side effects.

TYPHOID (TYPHIM VI i.m by Aventis Pasteur) - Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda & Rwanda

Recommended for unvaccinated travellers of all ages.

YELLOW FEVER VACCINATIONS

We base our Yellow Fever requirement advice on the WHO countries with risk of yellow fever transmission and countries requiring yellow fever vaccination as well as the procedures implemented on the ground in each country.

Kenya & Tanzania

Passengers arriving from Yellow Fever endemic countries (listed below) are required to present a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate.

While official advice states that yellow fever vaccinations are not required when travelling from Tanzania to Kenya, we can confirm that on occasion, travellers arriving to Kenya from Tanzania are checked for Yellow Fever vaccinations.

We are in regular communication with Kenyan Port Health authorities and are working with them to receive clarification on this matter, however, for the time being our advice remains unchanged and we request that guests be vaccinated for Yellow Fever when travelling from Tanzania to Kenya.

Rwanda

- Passengers arriving from Yellow Fever endemic countries (listed below) and any country with active Yellow Fever transmission outbreaks are required to present a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate.
- These passengers will be required to:
 - undergo temperature screening on arrival;
 - consent to self-report any symptoms that they may experience in the 6 days following arrival in Rwanda;



- Passengers with a temperature above 38.5C will be granted entry into Rwanda but are required to isolate and undergo further investigation for Yellow Fever.

Uganda

All passengers over the age of 1 year are required to present a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate in order to enter Uganda.

Yellow Fever Endemic Countries

• Angola, Argentina, Benin, Bolivia, Brazil, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Colombia, Cote d'Ivoire, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Ecuador, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, French Guiana, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea Bissau, Guyana, Kenya, Liberia, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Nigeria, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Republic of the Congo, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, South Sudan, Sudan, Suriname, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda, United Republic of Tanzania, Venezuela

NB: Yellow Fever vaccinations are not required for travellers under the age of 1 year. Existing and new yellow fever vaccination certificates are now valid for life.

NOTE: transit passengers (more than 12 hours) in Tanzania require a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate. Transit passengers (less than 12 hours) in Kenya or Tanzania shall not be checked for compliance with the certification.
